## Statement

The series *World Watching* Wanda concentrates on the relationship between naked body and landscape uniting them in one single image. In her work Wanda attempts to reintroduce the nude into nature a beautiful, pristine and romantic environment long since abandoned by mankind, her work is a documentation of the evolution of atmosphere, place, emotions and sensuality. The absence of colour highlights the connection through lighting and form with the nude to the landscape.

## Biography

Wanda Michalak is an established Amsterdam based Artist, born in Poland Wanda studied photography at the Carrington Polytechnic Design School in Auckland New Zealand. She has exhibited extensively throughout Europe, New Zealand and Australia including *Ten* Rudolf Gallery Amsterdam, *Time Remembered* Centre for Contemporary Art Warsaw Poland and *World Watching* Galeria Luksfera Warsaw. Wanda has taught photography in Amsterdam and Warsaw and opened the Gallery WM in Amsterdam.
