## Statement

The artists in this group exhibition use photography to give a new perspective to unseen things and events in our everyday lives.

Anne Collins has used everyday images of people and places and has digitally manipulated and joined them, so that we will wonder about the mostly overlooked dark and often hidden side of life.

Pat Bolger works in black and white using the techniques of Man Ray to show us that still life can have movement and that it can suggest other life that we hadn't noticed is happening. She reveals the beauty and poetry of tiny earthly things using light alone.

Ruth Francis uses unusual lenses turning ordinary objects into patterns and designs similar perhaps to those being discovered by scientists using modern day magnification. This too has let us see the possibility of the planets not yet discovered.
